All Saints' Memorial Hall

2 Ambrose Street, Hunters Hill

All Saints' Memorial Hall was built in thanksgiving for those who served in World War 2, and is therefore a 1950's classic!

It is a large and bright space with plenty of windows and a parquetry timber floor. It has reverse cycle air-conditioning for comfort. There is also a large stage area. It looks out onto beautiful trees and gardens.

It is currently used for children's groups, playgroups, exercise classes, meditation, music lessons, dinners and functions - and so is very versatile.

There is seating and tables available for up to 120 people (COVID restrictions pending).

St Mark's Memorial Hall

Figtree Road, Hunters Hill

Nestled on tree lined Figtree Road, and privately located behind St Mark's Church is St Mark's Memorial Hall.

This Hall was moved from its location in Church Street in 1962 to its current location, along with the entire church!

This air-conditioned space is able to accommodate around 40 people (COVID restrictions pending) and has a small kitchenette. The floor is timber.

It is currently used for dance, children's groups, meetings and a variety of events.



All Saints' Meeting Room

2 Ambrose Street, Hunters Hill



This small room is located at the front of All Saints' Memorial Hall, and is a great place for small meetings, counselling or private conversations.

While it is surrounded by glass that allows you to view the gardens and tree lined streets, it has blinds that can be closed to make it a more private space.

There is also a white board.

The room is set up for four people, but can accommodate up to eight (COVID restrictions pending).

The Upper Room

2 Ambrose Street,
Hunters Hill

This space is located above All Saints Memorial Hall, with glorious views towards the Harbour Bridge. It is used by our Children's Ministry, and a variety of other groups including writing, drama, music and exercise.

It is a lovely meeting space for any group, and can accommodate up to 30 comfortably (pending COVID restrictions).



Licence Fees

All users of our facilities enter into a licence agreement with the Wardens of the Parish, and are required to provide their own Public Liability Insurance as part of this agreement.

"One-Off" Events

These are defined as a one-off event, and are not repeated. An allowance of 10 minutes prior to and after usage for setting up and packing up. That equates to an additional 20 minutes of usage included within the rate of the first hour. Usage that extends beyond this will be charged at the rate below. A bond of \$500.00 is required for all "one-off" events.

"Regular" Bookings

These are defined as an event that occurs with a repeated occurrence and at the same time and usage of space within a one-month period. An allowance of 10 minutes prior to and after usage for setting up and packing up. That equates to an additional 20 minutes of usage included within the rate of the first hour. Usage that extends beyond this will be charged at the new rate below.

All Saints' Hall Meeting Room	\$15.50+ GST	\$10.50 + GST
