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**Family Minister, Anglican Parish of Hunters Hill**  
*(Permanent Part-time)*

The Anglican Parish of Hunters Hill includes the suburbs of Hunters Hill and Woolwich. While extremely close to the city, locals refer to it as a country town in the city.

The Parish draws people from across our community, and wider Sydney.

We are a diverse community, with people of all ages, and a variety of backgrounds. What we hold in common is our faith in Jesus Christ as our Lord and God, whom we worship within a traditional Anglican setting.

In 2025 our Parish wishes to build upon and further support ministry with our families. The purpose of this role is to work, under the supervision and authority of the Rector, with families and their children.

### **Duties**

There are three primary areas of focus of this ministry:

1. ASK (All Saints' Kids) takes place within our 10am service at All Saints' each Sunday. This program is parent and carer led, and we are seeking a person who would assist to coordinate and support our leaders, develop programs and work with the Rector to seek ways of becoming a more "intergenerational" community;
2. Special Religious Education Teacher (SRE) at Hunters Hill Public School occurs each Wednesday morning and we are seeking a person to both teach and coordinate this program;
3. Chaplaincy with our families. We desire a person who might provide pastoral care and support for our families, and also to work with them and walk alongside them as they seek to be faithful families.

### **Rémunération and Hours of Work**

Remuneration is as per the [Guidelines for a Lay Youth and Children Minister](#) in the Anglican Diocese of Sydney at the appropriate level of qualifications. We also pay appropriate superannuation and up to \$200.00 per month in travel.

We are seeking a person for the equivalence of two (2) days per week, and so the position is offered pro-rata on the above guidelines. Work primarily will occur on Wednesday (SRE) and Sunday (ASK) mornings, and at other times upon agreement with the Rector.
